We, the members of Windom Park Citizens in Action, request the Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board to preserve all of Stinson Parkway from both physical and visual encroachment by the Lowry Grove redevelopment, by:

- denying all exits from and access to the site at Stinson Parkway;
- encouraging incoming and outgoing traffic be directed away from Stinson Parkway toward New Brighton Blvd (Co. Rd. 88);
- preventing any reduction in MPRB land including but not limited to, any proposed carriage walks, turn lanes and parking lanes;
- enforcing the "NO Trucks" on Stinson Parkway;
- denying the eventual use of the Parkway to Lowry Grove residents for overnight parking;
- participation of a Park Board representative at the St. Anthony Village Planning Commission meeting on August 28, 2017;
- reviewing the developer's application for a Planned Unit Development and provide written input to the City of St. Anthony regarding the design, building architecture and scale in relation to its location on the Grand Rounds and National Scenic Byway.

To that end, we the members of Windom Park Citizens in Action request that a letter conveying these concerns be sent to each member of the Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board and Michael Schroeder, Assistant Superintendent of Planning, Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board.
