Minutes

- 1. Review of <u>January Meeting Minutes</u> Motion by CC to approve, 2nd by LW, Motion passes unanimously.
- 2. Staff Updates Thomas provides brief overview of several topics
 - a. Invite Police to next neighborhood meeting, possibly in place of Metro
 - b. Little interest in Roseville Community Band, but perhaps one from NE?

- 3. Windom Park Mural Project
 - a. Carrie and Rock introduce project and early concepts
 - b. Carrie describes impetus for project (vandalism mitigation)
 - c. Rock describes early thoughts on mural content:
 - i. Wants to connect theme ("Cultivating a thriving workforce") with nature and interesting aspects of neighborhood.
 - ii. Birds turkeys, cardinals, non-native species were discussed as possible content and ways to harmonize them with the park.
 - iii. Rock is also considering depicting the nationalities of Northeast through the birds represented in those communities.
 - iv. Also wants to have various pieces of organic material (perhaps nest components) creating the connection from primary walls (east/west) and secondary walls (north/south)
 - d. Rock will continue to consider these ideas and others and hopes to be in Minneapolis to attend the Arbor Day Celebration on 4/28 to gather more community input.
 - e. WPCIA will gather board input and send to Rock
- 4. Arbor Day Celebration
 - a. Project moving forward with several pieces to be discussed at next planning meeting (3/9).
 - b. WPCIA discussed scope of financial contributions and decided to offer up to \$5,000 in support of entertainment, signage, ads or other relevant needs.
- 5. Opioid & Narcan Project
 - a. Board considers next steps
 - b. Board would like to hear more of what CM Payne's office is interested in doing for the scope of the project.
